The series is a return to his childhood practice featuring twelve masterfully rendered portraits of the artist's relatives seated at the table surrounded by all of their important objects of life. Each is a wild and sensual world as seen by the imagination of the little artist at work below. The images form a circle around the gallery as a large interconnected table hinting at the look of "The Last Supper" attended by party of sexy-trashy hipsters from Rio.

The pieces are created with a combination of digital imaging, and paint software

Entry fee \$30US.

Show is international, open to all geographical locations.

Entrants submit one JPEG file of original work up to 2mb. All styles of 2D artwork and photography where digital processes of any kind were integral to the creation of the images are acceptable. Digital video stills and screen shots of web/new media are acceptable.

Multiple entries are permitted. Limit of 3 entries per person. \$30 registration fee for each additional image.

Multiple entries are permitted. Limit of 3 entries per person. \$30 registration fee for each additional image. Seperate registration required for each image.

Sales of Artwork:

Submissions will be included in our artists portfolio and will be offered for sale. Price and type of print to be determined when interest is shown by buyer in works by artist. Gallery retains 50% of all sales. Winners retain ownership of all intellectual property rights to their artwork and prints are made by permission only.
